

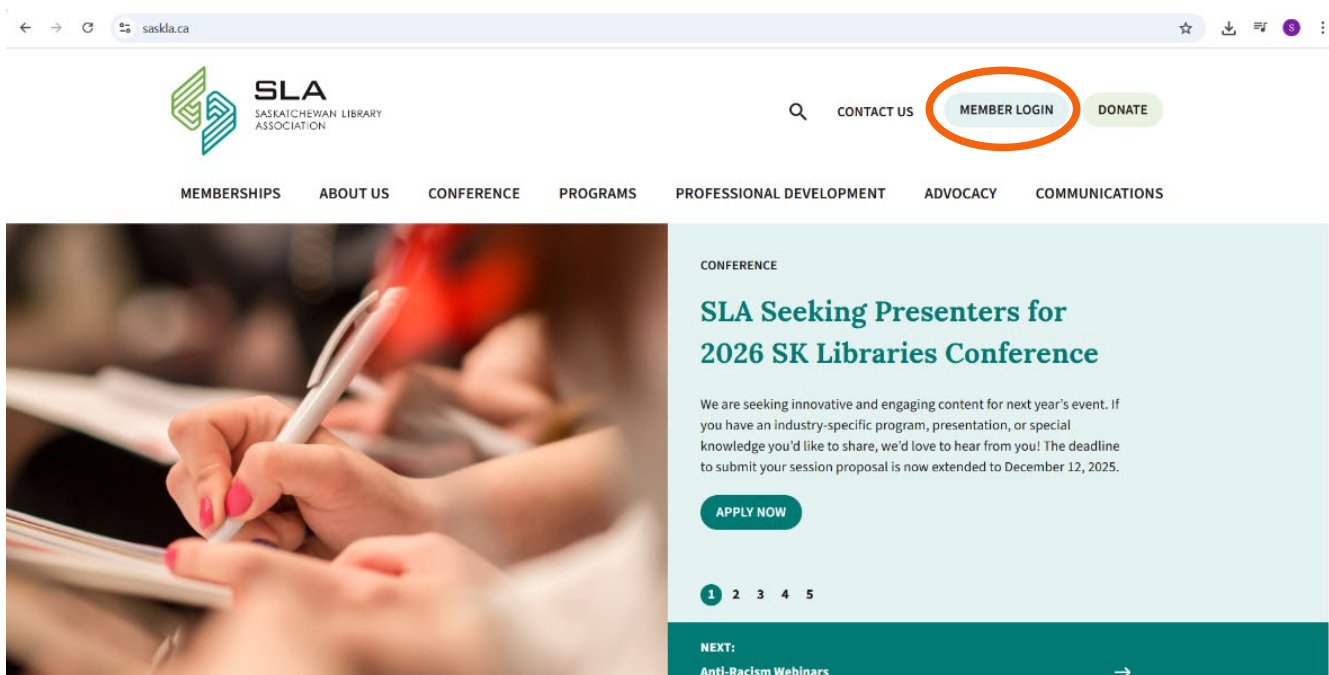
How to Get to the Member Forums

From a Computer:

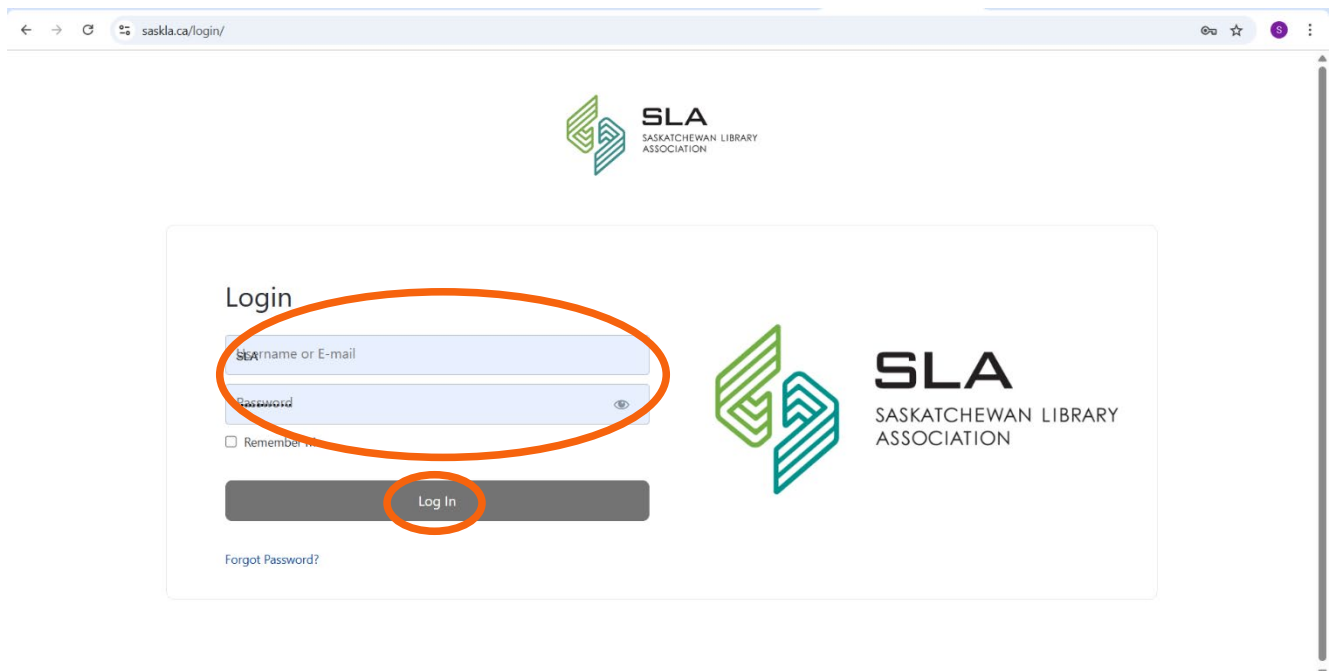
1. Visit us online at <http://www.saskla.ca>.

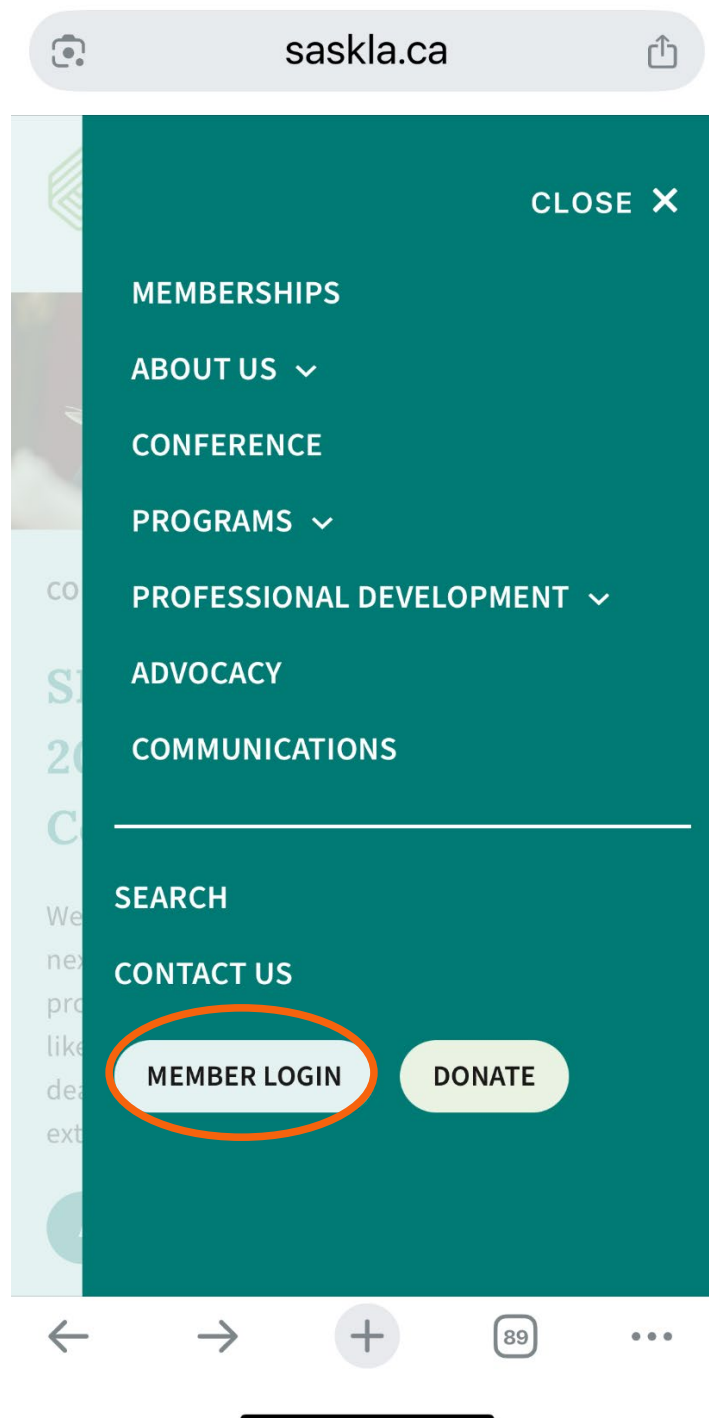

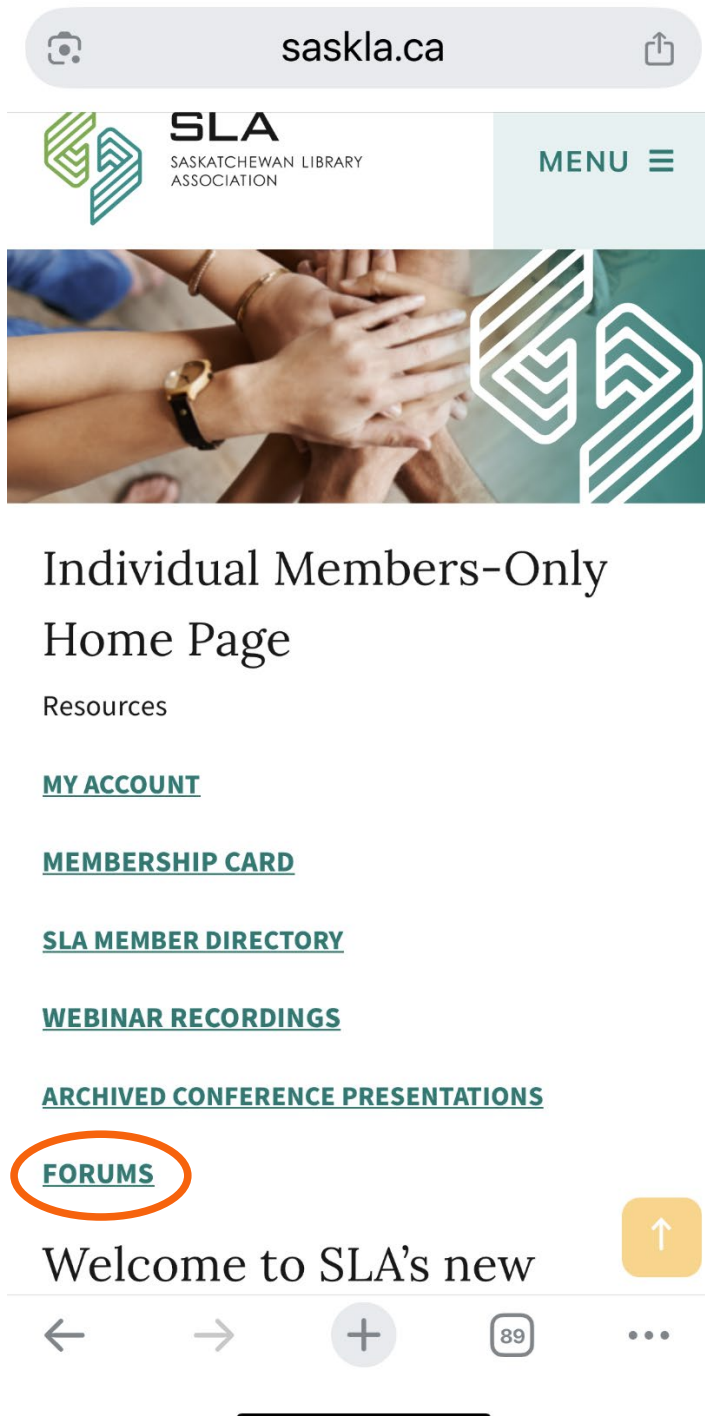

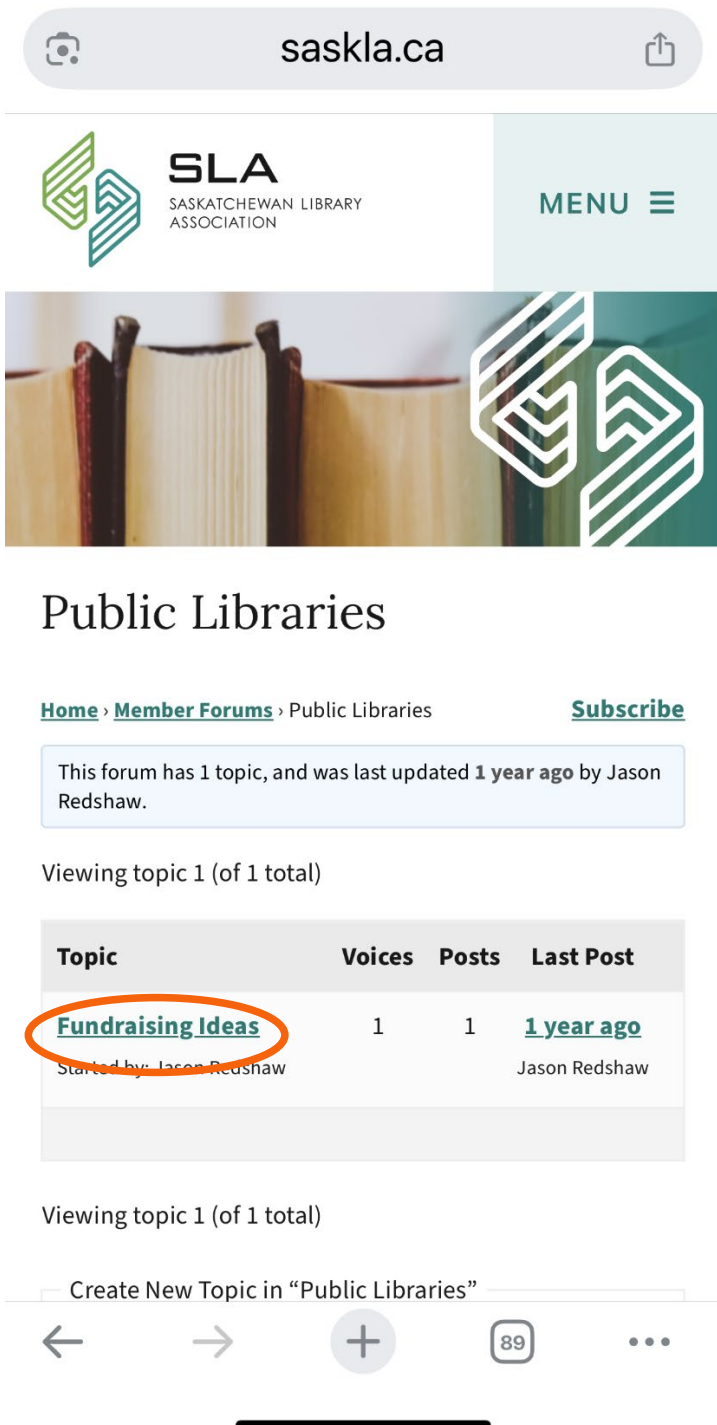
