# **Make the invisible, visible, then orient towards shared future**

- Simplify key messages re funding and contributions by local, regional, provincial
- Establish coherent provincial library value framework
  - Rural, urban, northern differentiations
  - Comprehensive, though still simple framework
  - Push for timely, complete, transparent reporting on various library data sets
- Re-organize + re-structure for SK's future provincial public library system
  - Discussions about re-structuring provincial system
  - Boundaries and re-organizing regions
  - Transcend partisan boundaries in discussions around library mission and goals
- Cultivate and support ongoing community work with stakeholder networks
  - F2F talking, meeting, influencing
  - Identify and connect loosely organized nodes in the network
  - Consultation and engagement activities
